GUIDANCE FOR WALKERS

1. Grading of Walks

All walks in the programme are graded as follows:-

"A" Strenuous for the fit; often over hills and rough terrain; could involve steep ascents and descents.

"B" Moderate; easier than "A" grade walks, but could have at least one of the features of an "A" (denoted by "+")

"C" Easy strolls, usually level walking.

2. MEETING POINT for all walks is at the INDIAN COTTAGE car park , Kilsyth Road, Kirkintilloch, at 8:50 for a 9am start. *PLEASE BE PROMPT* in order that transport can be arranged. *PETROL COSTS must be* shared by the occupants of each car.

If you wish to join the at the beginning of the walk please notify the leader beforehand.

3. Boots or stout footwear are essential on all walks.
Bring waterproof clothing, spare jumper / socks, packed lunch and a hot drink, have chocolate/barley sugar for emergencies!
